REGISTRATION PROCEDURE FOR ANCCE REGISTERED IMPORTED HORSES

The Owner must be a Full Financial Member of the AHAA.

Send Photocopies of the Relevant pages of the ANCCE Passport which has all the Horses' Information.

The Owner Must Fill Out an AHAA Application for Registration Form and send with the Appropriate Fees.

The Horse Must have DNA On File with Racing Australia, whether this is done through the AHAA testing, or Sent Through to That Laboratory by ANCCE or the Breeder/ owner.

The Horses' Details are then added to the AHAA Stud Book.

The AHAA Registration Certificate is Completed and Sent to the Owner of the Horse.

AI – IMPORTATION OF FROZEN SEMEN

The Owner of the Stallion, or Importer of the Semen Must Supply DNA Information to Racing Australia if resulting progeny are to be registered with the AHAA.

The Importer of the Semen Must Fill Out a Stud Service Return Each Season Listing Mares Supplied with Semen, and send to the Federal Secretary of the AHAA.

The Importer of the semen must supply a Service Certificate to each Mare Owner.

Resulting Progeny will be Registered with the AHAA, following the Same Procedures for Registration as foals of AHAA Registered Horses.
